JOURNAL ENTRY OF JUDGMENT

The captioned matter came before this Court for jury trial on April 20, 2026. Present were Plaintiff, Sophia Mahmoodjanloo and her attorneys, James A. Belote and Jack Stipe. Defendant, Omni Hotel Management Corporation d/b/a Omni Oklahoma City Hotel, a foreign corporation, was present with attorneys, Amy Sherry Fischer and Peyton S. McMillin.

The jury was empanelled and sworn on April 20, 2026. It heard the Plaintiff's evidence on April 21, 2026 and Plaintiff rested. The jury heard the Defendant's evidence on April 21, 2026 and Defendant rested. On April 21, 2026, the Court instructed the jury, and the jury heard argument of counsel and retired to deliberate and then returned its verdict in favor of Plaintiff selecting the White Verdict form, which provided:

We, the jury, empaneled and sworn in the above entitled cause, do, upon our oaths, find as follows:

1. Plaintiff's, Sophia Mahmoodjanloo, contributory negligence 20 %
2. Defendant's, Omni Oklahoma City Hotel's, negligence 80 %

“We find the dollar amount of damages sustained by the Plaintiff, Sophia Mahmoodjanloo, without regard to the percentages of contributory negligence of the Plaintiff, Sophia Mahmoodjanloo, and negligence of the Defendant, is the sum of \$1,000,000.00. This dollar amount will be reduced by the judge by the percentage established in Item 1 above.”

Pursuant to 12 O.S. § 727.1, Plaintiff is entitled to pre-judgment interest in the amount of Five Point Zero Six Percent (5.06%) from January 30, 2025 (which is 24 months after the suit resulting in the judgment was commenced), at the per diem rate of \$110.90 for 2025. For 2026, prejudgment interest is in the amount of Four Point One Three Percent (4.13%) from January 1, 2026, until May 1, 2026, at the per diem rate of \$90.52. Total pre-judgment interest is \$48,013.90.

Pursuant to 12 O.S. § 727.1, Plaintiff is entitled to post-judgment interest on the total judgment calculated in the amount of \$848,013.90, which represents the amount of the judgment plus pre-judgment interest, at a rate of Eight Point Seven Five Percent (8.75%) from May 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, and thereafter at the rates prescribed in accordance with 12 O.S. § 727.1 until the judgment is paid.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged, and decreed that judgment be entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant in the amount of \$848,013.90 plus post-judgment interest as calculated herein.

The determination of any recovery for cost is reserved and may be presented to the Court in accordance with 12 OS §696.4(B).

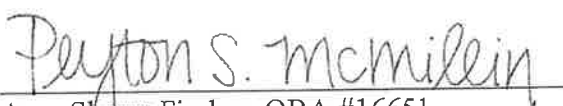
